Millions face starvation as world warms, say scientists

- Parts of Africa will be disaster areas
- World unprepared, say food experts

Millions of people could become destitute in Africa and Asia as staple foods result of extreme temperatures, floods and droughts that will transform the way the world farms.

As food experts gather this week at two major conferences to discuss how to feed the nine billion people expected to be alive in 2050, leading scientists have

expected global population increase and changing demand. Climate change lion gains we have come to expect – will not go away by climate change. We are food produced so much as the vulnerability of the one billion people who are without food already and who will be hit hardest by climate change. They have no capacity to adapt.

America's agricultural economy is set to undergo dramatic changes over the next three decades, as warmer temperatures devastate crops, according to a US government report. The report predicts that a gradually warming climate and unpredictably severe weather across two-thirds of the continent will have serious consequences for food

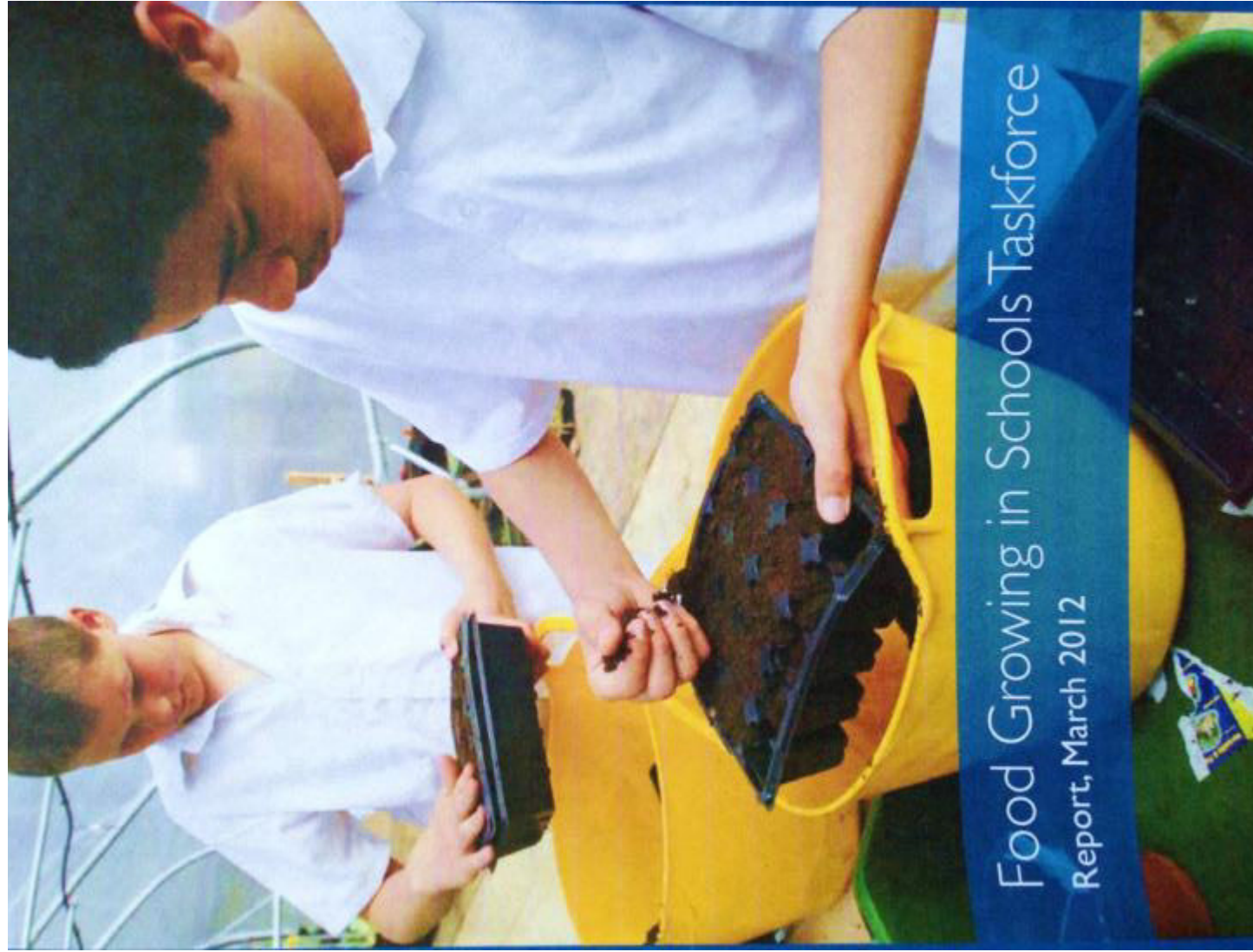

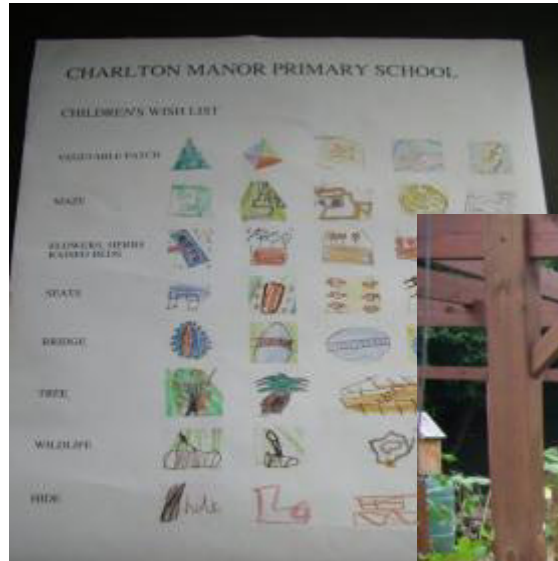

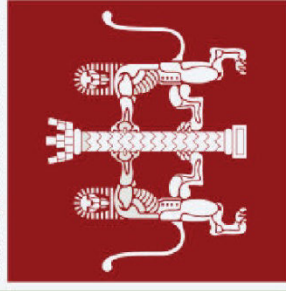
