"We are not in business to save lives, but to earn money – saving lives is not our concern."







Natural Medicine

is a combination of the advantages of

modern medicine
and the advantages of

traditional herbal medicine.



Modern medicine has

- * a scientific basis
- reliable methods of preparation
- * good packaging
- * clear labels
- * accurate dosages
- * clear expiry dates



Traditional herbal medicine

- uses locally available resources
- accords with the local language and culture
- * is almost always available, even in the remotest regions



Natural Medicine

- * has a scientific basis
- uses reliable methods of preparation
- is hygienically packaged
- has clear labels
- uses accurate dosages
- * gives clear expiry dates

AND

- uses locally available resources
- accords with the local language and culture
- * is almost always available, even in the remotest regions.

Cough and bronchitis.





Diarrhoea

In the Tropics, diarrhoea is a very common cause of death among infants, killing more than 1.5 million per year.

Most of these children need not die!!!

Diarrhoea can almost always be easily treated!

If only people knew how!!!!



With Natural Medicine

First we make our own

Oral Rehydration Solution, (ORS)

with boiled water, half a level teaspoonful of salt and two heaped tablespoonfuls of sugar.

Administer with an accurate dosage

Adults	3500

Euphorbia hirta (asthma weed)





Psidium guajava (guava)





Mangifera indica (mango)





To make and use anti-amoeba tea

- * Take one handful of each fresh green plant material.
- * Wash.
- Boil in one litre of water for 3 minutes.
- * Allow to steep for half an hour.
- Drink in the course of the day for 8 days.



Simple! A true life saver!

With these procedures, many thousands of lives have already been saved.

The burden of malaria

- * There are at least 300 million acute cases of malaria each year globally, resulting in more than a million deaths.
- * That means 3000 people die every day from malaria, mostly children.
- * Could we describe anopheles as the world's worst terrorist?



It's getting worse

* Malaria kills more African children under 5 than any other infectious agent.

* The old conventional medicines like chloroquine do not work any more.



The cost of malaria

Economists believe that, in some African countries, malaria reduces the rate of economic growth by 1.3%



Treatment?

- * Less than 20% of patients with fever, or even dying from malaria, visit the formal health system. 80% of patients self-treat at home or visit a traditional healer.
- Modern drugs are often
 - unavailable, or
 - unaffordable, or
 - are even fakes.
- * Even when modern drugs are used, they are usually used at an incorrect dose.



WHO and Millennium Goals

To have halted by 2015 and begun to reverse the incidence of malaria and other major diseases.



But how?

That is the big question

?



Artemisia annua is an answer!

Artemisia annua contains more than ten anti-malarial components, on of which is artemisinin, a substance that clears plasmodium from the blood faster and more effectively than any other known drug.

It is the hope of the world!



A "good-tasting" alternative: *Artemisia* annua anamed tea!



The tea contains ten anti-malarial substances
– a natural combination therapy!

Better not as a monoculture ...





Harvest, dry, sieve and package the leaves











Scattered throughout these countries are grass-roots projects that grow Artemisia and use it to treat malaria and several other diseases.


- * Artemisia tea strengthens the immune system of those who are HIV positive, and even of AIDS-Patients

Artemisia tea is also effective


- * in treating eye infections

Many people now claim to practice "Natural Medicine", but ...

... how can we integrate "anamedopathy" into formal health care provision?



If 80% of the population do not use the formal health system...

then it is important to rethink our approach to health and healing



1. Explain "anamedopathy"

It is a brand new philosophy and way of working.

It is not: traditional medicine, homeopathy, complimentary medicine, modern medicine



2. Train every doctor, nurse and primary health care worker in Natural Medicine

3. Train every traditional herbalist in Natural Medicine

4. Train doctors, nurses and traditional healers together, and mutual understanding and respect will develop.

5. Every hospital can have a medicinal garden





6. And every hospital pharmacy

can produce

- medicinal teas,
 e.g. for diarrhoea
 and malaria.
- medicinal oils and ointments, e.g. for rheumatism.
- herbal tinctures,e.g. for coughs.







7. Every hospital can work in tandem with Home-based Care





For example: Home-based Care in Manicaland Province, Zimbabwe

- * Has 4000 volunteer care givers, who are being trained in Natural Medicine.
- * They teach people how to grow medicinal plants and how to use them in their own homes.

Natural Medicine also includes

- Conservation farming
- * Water conservation
- Planting trees
- * Hygiene
- * Clean water
- * Toilets
- * Nutrition





In every tropical country there is a great wealth



of experience, of people and of resources.



Self-reliance

anamed has the aim that

- * Families
- * Health centres
- * University clinics
- * Healers

use these resources, in order to

- reduce costs
- become more self-sufficient
- become more effective



The former United Nations SecretaryGeneral Kofi A. Annan:

"We will have time to reach the Millennium Development Goals — but only if we break with business as usual."



Many governments want to register traditional healers, in order to:

- * control them
- * tax them
- * take their knowledge of medicinal plants in order to make money from patents



In contrast, anamed wishes to enable every family to create their own health centre in their own home,

- * to avoid taxes.
- * to enable them to treat health problems free of charge.
- * to avoid theft of intellectual property.



When Jesus healed

- * He paid no taxes to Rome.
- * He encouraged his disciples to heal people outside the formal health system.
- * He never charged.
- * He healed and taught in the public
- * He healed people irrespective of their status, gender, religion or politics.
- * He used the available resources.
- * He made a good relationship with all his patients.
