








What's a farmer?

- Interchangeable products
- Specialization, rationalization → reduction

Production Alternatives

Principles:

- Careful use of resources and ecological efficiency
- Sustainability, enrichment of humus, Circulation systems
- Seasonality
- Diversity
- Focus on new systems instead of problems
- Preservation and support of small scaled farms
- Communication ("Supply of services")

The Schoenbrunn Seminars try to bring together propagators throughout the food chain – people involved in growing, commercializing, processing and consumption.
















